WHAT DO WE ACTUALLY PUT ON THE DISCS?

Basically, we are trying to show lots of different faces of people who are in the Army. These are faces of people who we are wanting to say thank you to; the main reason we have Armed Forces Day. The 'faces' side of the disc should have a standard format. How many of which colour is addressed on Information Sheet 4

On the other side of the disk is a chance for the young person to show their thanks in whatever way they like. It could just be the words 'thank you' or even just a coloured pattern. They may want it to be more elaborate.

Please bear in mind that participants may well not get the disc back again.

AN EXAMPLE

Make sure that the hole is at the top of the disc!

The face does not need to be painted on. You could use any media you want. Pencil crayon is highly recommended. you may want to draw the face separately and cut it out, collage it on, then varnish over.

You do not need to write the job area, but you can. You may want to give the person a name ... add that if you want! (a Sharpie type pen is good for this)

The background colour needs to be consistent see Information Sheet 2

When creating the faces ensure you reflect the Army's wide ethnic diversity and gender mix.

The 'thank you' side can be whatever the young people want! (if they include their names please ensure first names only)
